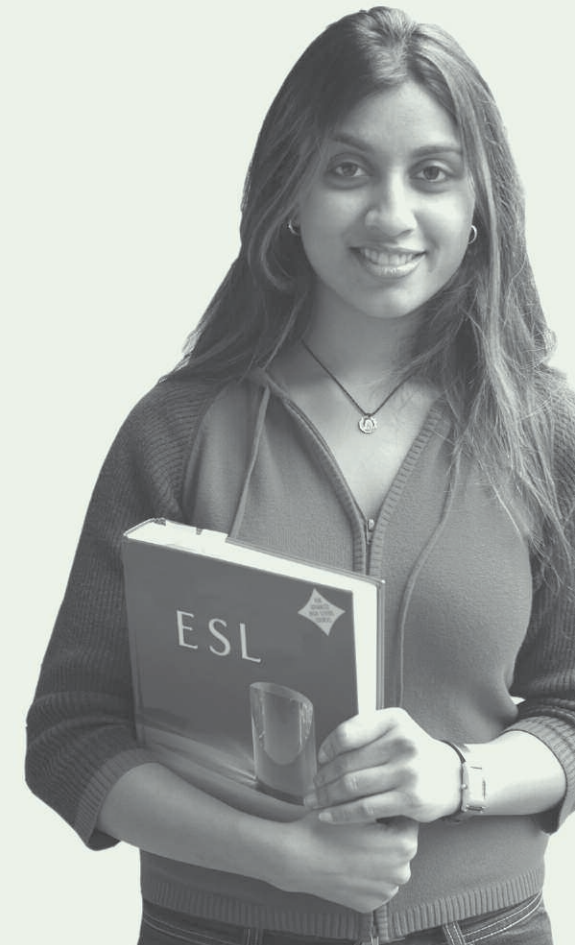

About the Program

This learning community cluster allows students to complete ESL Level III courses in an intensive, supportive environment during the eight-week summer semester.

Prerequisites: GPA of 3.0 or better in all ESL level II courses, ESL placement test, or a minimum TOEFL score of 473 (paper)/150 (computer) and a writing sample.

Student Costs

Course tuition and fees are the same as for the regular academic semester. Please refer to the BHCC Summer Course Schedule for details. Participants pay for their own lunch and any costs related to the optional Friday trips. Two special luncheons for students, instructors, and staff in the cluster are included at no extra cost.

Cluster Components

ESL COURSES

Academic Note-Taking III (ESL096), Academic Speaking III (ESL097), Academic Reading III (ESL098), and Academic Writing III (ESL099)

COMPUTER-ASSISTED LANGUAGE LEARNING

Students are required to spend at least 4 hours in the Language Lab using language-learning software for extra grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary practice.

Students may choose to participate in the following support activities to enhance their learning experience:

CONVERSATION GROUPS

The groups provide an opportunity to have informal lunchtime conversation practice with instructors and staff.

TUTORING

Individualized help with course work is available after classes.

FRIDAY EXCURSIONS

Staff and students may join optional Friday trips to local places of interest such as Chinatown, the North End, the Harbor area, or Charlestown. Participants pay their own expenses.
