Eligibility Guidelines	Additional Information
<p><b>A. Final Cumulative G.P. A. of 2.0 or Higher</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Waives the admissions application fee and essay</li> <li>• Guarantees the full transfer of college-level credits, including “D” grades, applied to the degree requirements of the linked baccalaureate degree or school at the state college or University of Massachusetts</li> <li>• Satisfies the general education requirements at the receiving institution with the receiving institution able to add no more than six additional credits / two courses in compliance with the New England Association of Schools and Colleges’ Standards for Accreditation.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students must complete an “Intent to Enroll” form at the Admissions and Registration Office.</li> <li>• “Full transfer” ensures that a minimum of 60 credits must be transferred and applied to the linked baccalaureate program <i>UNLESS</i>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ the student changes his or her major;</li> <li>○ the linked baccalaureate program requires a higher grade point average;</li> <li>○ specific courses for the major are required of native students.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>B. Final Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.5 or Higher</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grants all of the benefits outlined in section A.</li> <li>• Guarantees admission to the linked baccalaureate degree or school at a Massachusetts state college or University of Massachusetts campus.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Admission is guaranteed <i>UNLESS</i>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ the linked baccalaureate program requires a higher grade point average;</li> <li>○ because of space or fiscal limitations the receiving institution does not admit all qualified applicants to a given major or program.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Students must be in good academic, fiscal and disciplinary standing with all previous institutions.</li> </ul>
<p><b>C. Final Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or Higher</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grants all of the benefits outlined in both sections A and B.</li> <li>• Guarantees a tuition waiver equal to 33% of the Massachusetts resident tuition rate at a state college or University campus for two years of undergraduate enrollment.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enrollment must be continuous at the state college or UMass campus;</li> <li>• The student must earn a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher for the first year of enrollment at the state college or UMass campus.</li> </ul>
