## What is the World Studies Certificate?

It is an additional credential that you can obtain that demonstrates that you have acquired the knowledge, skills and competencies needed to live and work in a globally interdependent world. The common objective of the courses is to foster the ability to appreciate, analyze and deal constructively with historical or contemporary experiences of diversity in the United States and other parts of the world. The certificate menu includes courses in the areas of geography, history, languages, literature, religion, science, and sociology.

## Why Should I Enroll in the World Studies Certificate?

It adds a credential to your official college transcript which would be an asset if you are planning to transfer to a bachelors degree-granting college or university.

It allows you to promote yourself to future employers as a person who has an understanding of world issues and is capable of working within a multicultural environment.

## Who is Eligible for the World Studies Certificate?

Any student who is matriculated in an Associate in Arts degree program at Bunker Hill Community College can enroll in the World Studies Certificate program simultaneously.



## Will I Have to Take Additional Courses to Get the World Studies Certificate?

No, you do not need to take additional courses to earn the World Studies Certificate. By careful selection of the general education and elective courses for your Associate in Arts degree program, you can obtain a World Studies Certificate without any extra coursework.

## What Courses Do I Have to Take to Get a World Studies Certificate?

The World Studies Certificate menu includes more than 35 courses in seven different areas. You will choose five courses from a minimum of three different areas. You should work with your academic advisor to make sure that you choose courses that will fulfill the requirements of your Associate in Arts degree program as well as the World Studies Certificate.
