

2011 BHCC Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

Scholarship applications can be picked up at the Financial Aid Office, Room B-213, the Student Activities Office (D106) on the Charlestown Campus and on the Chelsea Campus at the Front Desk in the Main Lobby. Students should read the eligibility criteria carefully and submit only what is required for each scholarship. Qualified applications will be reviewed by a Committee and recipients of each award will be notified. **Please note: a student may receive only one scholarship covering tuition and fees for a specified semester.**

<p>Academic Excellence Award for Continuing Students</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a continuing BHCC Student; earned at least 15 credits at BHCC; achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher; and be enrolled full-time (12 credits) for the semester in which the award is given.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>	
<p>Deputy Warden John A. Blaney Scholarship</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a continuing BHCC second semester Criminal Justice student; have cumulative GPA of 3.50 or higher; intend to complete A.S. in Criminal Justice. Recipient receives \$1,500 for the Fall 2012 semester.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>	<p>Boston Sand & Gravel Company Scholarship</p> <p>Eligibility: Awarded to two BHCC students with cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher; must exemplify the institutional values of the college; intend to complete either an A.S. or an A.A. degree at BHCC. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>
<p>BHCC Charlestown Housing Development Award</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a new or continuing BHCC student who is a resident of the Boston Housing Authority in Charlestown. Must be a continuing student with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>	<p>BHCC Charlestown Resident Award</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a new or continuing student who is a resident of Charlestown, MA; demonstrated outstanding service to the Charlestown community; have cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher; submit 2 letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with applicants' achievements. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>
<p>BHCC Chelsea Resident Scholarship</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a continuing student who is a resident of Chelsea; have completed 15 credits at BHCC; have cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>	<p>BHCC Memorial Scholarship</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a continuing BHCC student enrolled part time (6-11 credits) for Spring 2012; completed at least 15 credits at BHCC; have cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher; enrolled part-time (6-11 credits) for Fall 2012 semester. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>
<p>English as a Second Language Award</p> <p>Eligibility: Awarded to two new or continuing students; must have cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher; matriculated into a degree program; completed at least 6 credits of ESL at BHCC; be enrolled for at least 6 credits for the Fall 2012 semester. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>	<p>Refrigeration Service Engineers Scholarship (RSES)</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a continuing BHCC student in an associates' degree; concentrating on mathematics or physics/engineering; satisfactorily completed 30 credits; entering their second year at BHCC with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>
<p>James R. Ware Stop & Shop Scholarship</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be enrolled in the Business Administration program; earned at least 20 credits at BHCC with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>	<p>Stanley Z. Koplik Scholarship</p> <p>Eligibility: Must be a continuing BHCC student with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher; enrolled in a minimum of 9 credits at BHCC. Must be enrolled in an A.A. or A.S. degree program that is approved for Joint Admissions with the Massachusetts State Colleges and UMass. Renewable for Spring 2013 semester if student maintains eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Deadline: March 2, 2012</p>
