*In addition to meeting the requirements above, the student must have maintained an overall grade point average (GPA) of C for the 11th and 12th grade in order to receive articulated credits into the college's Network Technology and Administration Option or Certificate.

Students who have fulfilled the learning competencies/outcome objectives as identified by their high school transcript are recommended as being competent in these subject matters and can be recognized for a total of three (3) transfer credits at Bunker Hill Community College as outlined above.

Applicants for credit must meet all the admission requirements of Bunker Hill Community College and be an enrolled/registered student before credit is awarded.

3.0 Terms for Terminating this Agreement: This agreement is for an indefinite period of time; however, a biennial Spring review shall be conducted to assess the current status of the agreement and to make recommendations for modification as necessary. This review committee shall consist of the following persons:

- 3.1 High School Tech Prep Site Team (Computer Instructors, Tech Prep Coordinator, Guidance Counselor, Vocational Education Director)
- 3.2 Principal, of the High School
- 3.3 Academic Dean of Professional Studies of the College
- 3.4 Computer Information Technology Department Chairperson and/or designated faculty.

This agreement, mutually agreed upon by the representatives of the College and the High School, may be terminated at any time by either party with sixty (60) days prior notice.
