COME PREPARED.....In order to help all BHCC students asking for assistance with FAFSA on the Web please read all of the following information. The more prepared you are the shorter the visit. Students who come unprepared may be asked to come back when they have all the necessary information ready.

- ✓ If you have access to a computer we encourage you to try to complete as much of the FAFSA on the Web as you can before coming in to the Financial Aid Office. Most students have little difficulty with the basic information such as name, address, etc. Save the information you enter and we can help you with the rest when you come in to see us.
- ✓ **Bring your PIN number.** Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov to request a PIN or to have your PIN sent to you again if you have misplaced the information. You need an email address to request a PIN.
- ✓ Bring you and your parent's (if you are a dependent student) **2007 federal tax return including all schedules and W-2 statements.** Bringing the tax return gets the information into FAFSA right the first time! Corrections and incomplete information can delay the review of your application and award notification.
- ✓ If you are a dependent student bring your **parent(s) date of birth and Social Security Number.**
- ✓ Bring **documentation of all non-taxable income sources** that you and your parent's (if you are a dependent student) received in 2007, including SSI; SSDI; TANF; etc.
- ✓ Non-citizens must bring their **Alien Registration Number** with them.

2008-2009 Financial Aid Priority Filing Deadline Date is May 1, 2008!

Meeting this deadline date will maximize the opportunity for funds if you are determined eligible for financial aid.
