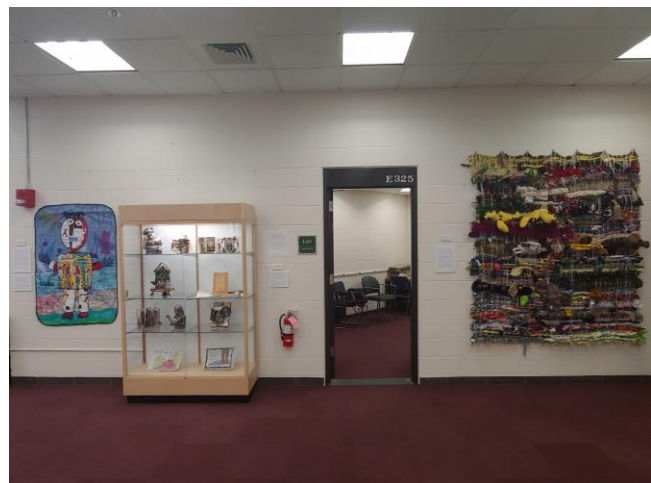

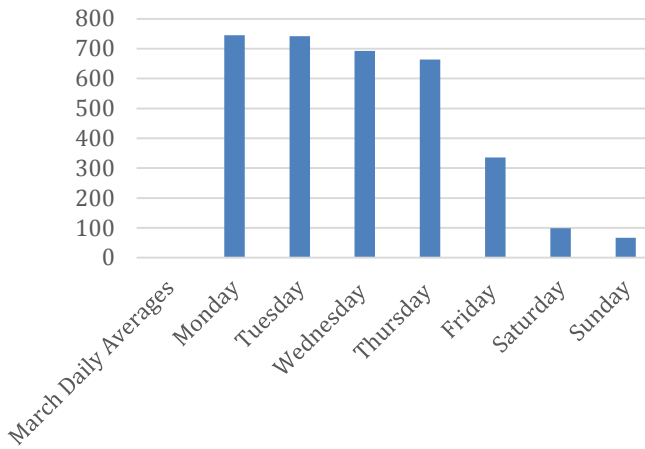

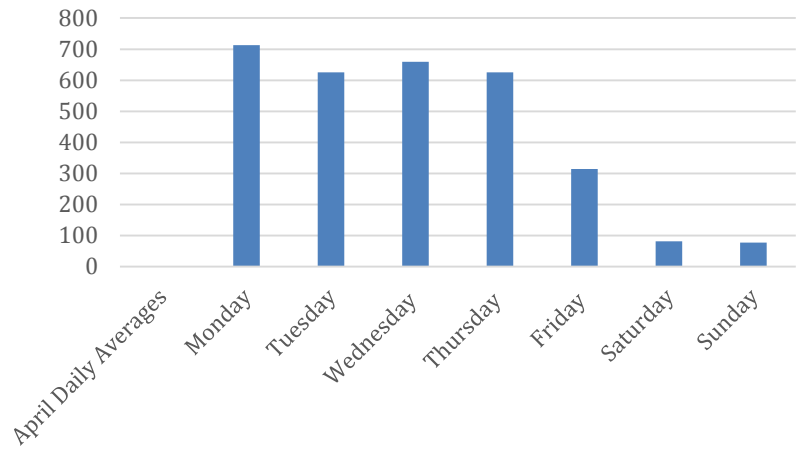

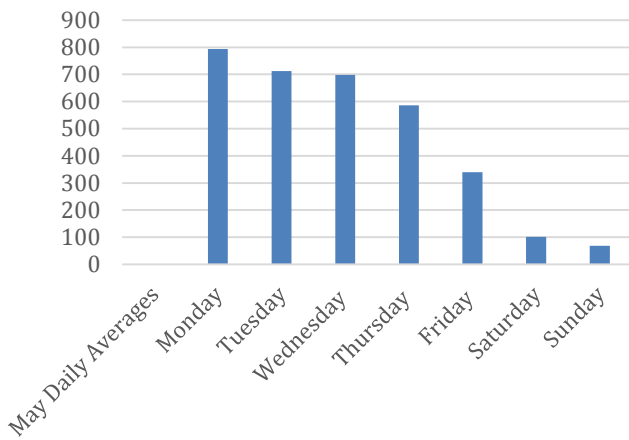
March 2019 People Counts



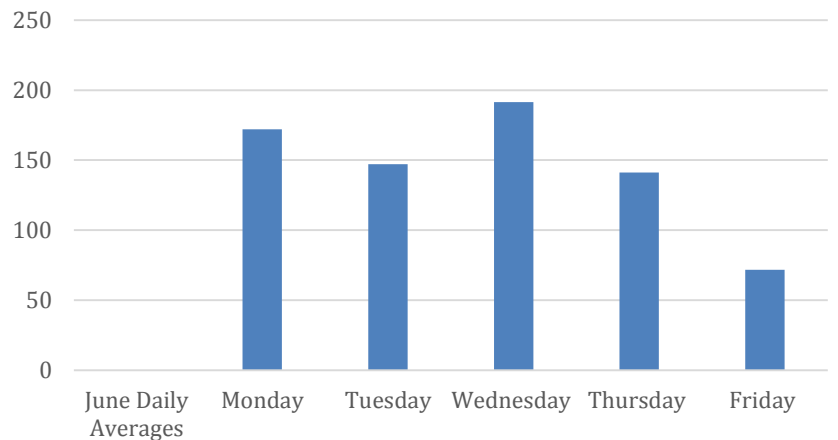
April 2019 People Counts
